### **Standard of Practice: Multiple Clinic Locations**

The Nova Scotia Chiropractic and Naturopathic Regulator (NSCNR) recognizes that some registrants may practice at multiple clinic locations and/or may operate “satellite clinics” with multiple locations of one corporate entity.

**All satellite clinics or additional clinic locations are required to meet the same standards of practice as required in a primary clinic.**

Please ensure that all standards of practice are applied to each clinic location. Particular attention should be given to NSCNR Standard of Practice - Patient Record Management to ensure file completeness, accuracy and privacy related to patient care.

Corporation Permits and Reserved Practice Permits must be displayed at each location where applicable. If a single permit issued covers multiple locations, contact the NSCNR for additional copies of your permit for display.
