

1. INTRODUCTION

The Nova Scotia Chiropractic and Naturopathic Regulator (NSCNR) is the regulatory authority for the practice of chiropractic and naturopathy in the Province of Nova Scotia.

The NSCNR serves and protects the public interest to advance ethical and competent chiropractic and naturopathic care in Nova Scotia.

A NSCNR Standard of Practice establishes the minimum professional practice expectations for Registrants holding an active naturopath license with the NSCNR who also hold a Reserved Practice Permit to perform **Ozone and Oxidative Therapies** and are therefore authorized to perform these Reserved Practices.

This document contains pre-approved specific component training programs required for successful application.

2. APPROVAL PROCESS

Specific component training is approved by the NSCNR via the Continued Education Committee.

Pre-approval ensures that training taken will comply with the requirements for Ozone and Oxidative Therapies. It is recommended to determine applicability for permit qualifications prior to enrolment.
