

To Whom It May Concern,

This letter confirms that the person presenting this letter (with verification of identification) is a registrant/applicant with the **Nova Scotia Chiropractic and Naturopathic Regulator**. As part of the registration and licensing requirements under the *Nova Scotia Regulated Health Professions Act*, all applicants are required to provide a current **Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Search** completed by the RCMP or regional Police Department.

An individual's criminal record history is reviewed against the list of relevant or specified offences as applicable in determining the risk that an individual may pose in a position where they work with children and/or vulnerable adults directly; or having or potentially having unsupervised access to children and/or vulnerable adults.

An applicant who has a criminal record for one or more of the offenses contained in the vulnerable sector check may be denied licensure or granted a license with conditions or restrictions.

We request that a **Vulnerable Sector Check** be completed for the individual. The results should be provided directly to the registrant/applicant, who will forward them to the NSCNR as part of their registration process.

All fees associated with obtaining the vulnerable sector check are the responsibility of the practitioner.
